


Prepaid Card Transaction: Is it possible to check the expiration of a customer card directly in the prepaid card transaction screen?

Solution: to restrict the refilling of expired prepaid cards, please use the following steps,

Step1: Setting the option

1. Go to [Main Menu > Sale Management > Transaction > Prepaid \(S>T>P\)](#)
2. Press **Alt + O**
3. Set “**Allow Expired Card = No**” (you can also set it to “**Yes**” or “**Ask**” as per your requirement).
4. Press **F10** to Save



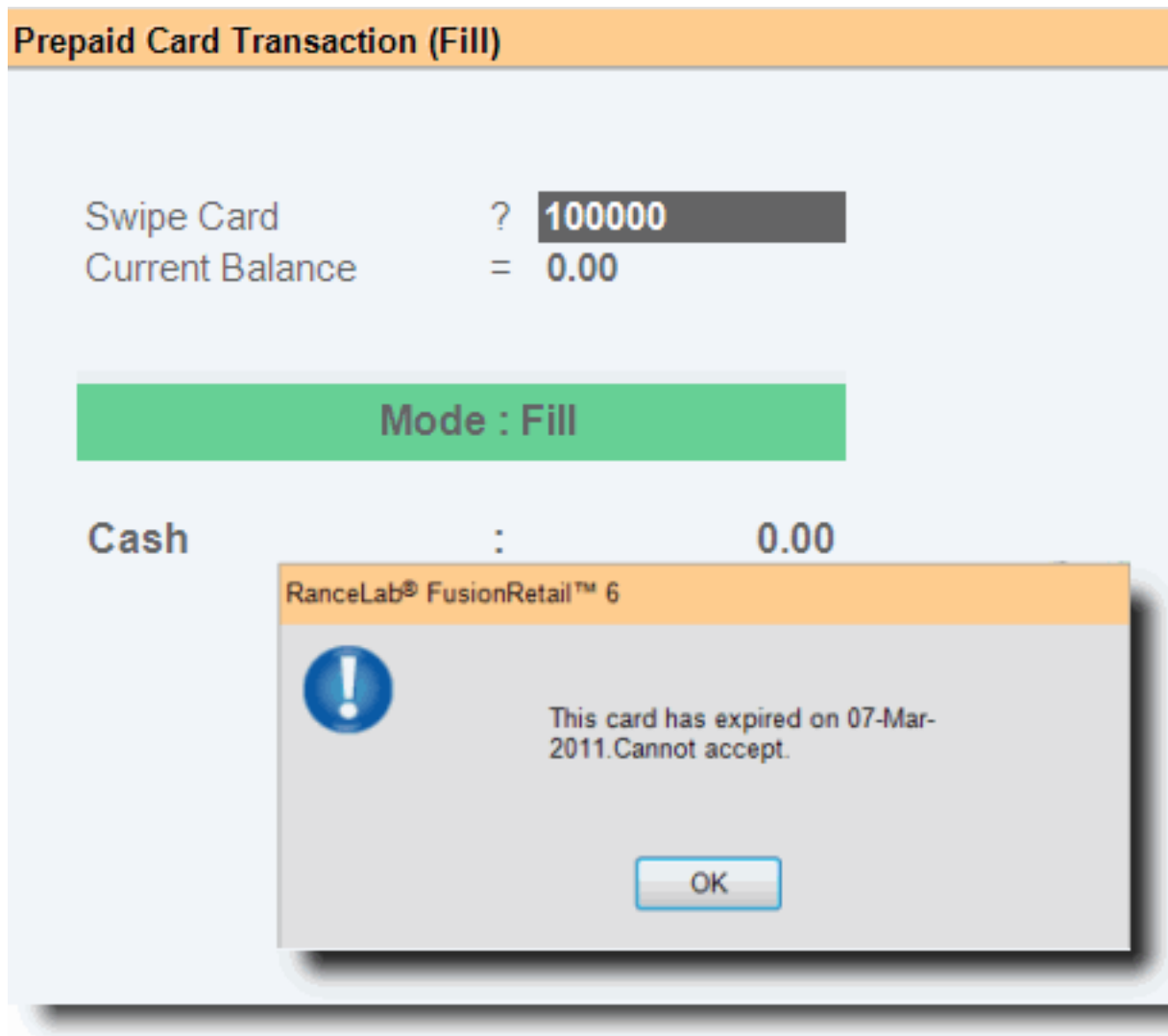
